## **DEVELOPMENTAL STATISTICS**

## Andhra Pradesh

- **ECONOMY:** A state's performance is often reflected by the health of its economy. The first two parameters that are checked to measure the well-being of an economy are GSDP (Gross State Domestic Product) growth rate and PER CAPITA INCOME.
  - In 2019, when Chandrababu Naidu left as CM of Andhra Pradesh, the state was ranked 22nd in India in terms of GSDP growth rate. Do you know where Andhra Pradesh stands as per the last RBI report (2021-22)? Andhra Pradesh ranks NUMBER 1 in the country.
  - o **In 2019,** the per capita income of Andhra Pradesh was at the **17th position** in the country. Today, Andhra Pradesh is among the top 10 states in the country, the per capita income of AP **ranks 9th.**
  - During 5 years of the TDP Government, the total number of government jobs provided was just 34,108. Jagan Anna's Government to date has provided 4,93,000 government jobs out of which 2,13,662 are permanent.
- **AGRICULTURE:** 62% of Andhra Pradesh's population is directly dependent on agriculture. **In 2019**, the agricultural sector growth of Andhra Pradesh was ranked at **27th position, second last in the country.** The growth rate was **NEGATIVE (minus 6.5%)** at that time. Today, under Jagan Anna's government, Andhra Pradesh **ranks 6th in the country with a growth rate of 8.2%.** This marks a transformative revolution, a shot in the arm for the backbone of our economy.
- **INDUSTRIES:** Yellow media tries to paint a propaganda that the growth of industries in Andhra Pradesh has gone to its lowest. Here is the truth:-

- In 2019, as per the Reserve Bank of India, during Chandrababu Naidu's regime, the growth rate of industries in Andhra Pradesh was ranked at 22nd position in the country. Today (2021-2022), under Jagan Anna's government, Andhra Pradesh is ranked an impressive 3rd in the entire country.
- **Ease Of Doing Business**: Andhra Pradesh for the **past two consecutive years has ranked NUMBER 1** in Ease Of Doing Business (2019-2020 and 2020-2021).
- During Chandrababu Naidu's government (2014-2019), only 37,956 new MSMEs were established across the state. In the last 4 years of Jagan Anna's government, the number of new MSMEs has INCREASED BY SIX TIMES TO 2.5 LAKH. Today, these MSMEs are generating employment for 16.57 LAKH people.
- Industry giants like Microsoft, Jindal, Reliance, Adani, Laurus Synthesis, TCS, Infosys, Hero Motocorp, Yokohama, Grasim Industries, Greenko Energy and many more well known industries have invested in Andhra Pradesh in the last 4 years alone.
- EDUCATION: Quality education is at the heart of Jagan Anna's government. Rs 11,700 Crores have been spent to renovate 38,059 schools in the last 4 years.
  - Unlike any other state in India, Jagan Anna government is converting classrooms to digital learning spaces. So far 60,000 Interactive Flat Panels, and 10,000 Smart TVs have been installed. 5.8 Lakh BYJUs tablets have been given to students.
  - o However, introduction of English in govt schools has been the real gamechanger. It is because of this that 10 government school students

hailing from humble backgrounds were selected to represent the state at prestigious global institutions like the United Nations, World Bank and International Monetary Fund (IMF) in September this year.

- **HEALTH:** Quality and affordable healthcare for all, is another cornerstone of Jagan Anna's Government. **In order to achieve this, in the last 4 years alone,** over **10,000 YSR Village Clinics, 1126 Primary Health Centres, and 524 Urban Clinics have been made ready.** 
  - Under the unprecedented month-long Jagananna Aarogya Suraksha Campaign - 12,056 medical camps were conducted, approximately 3.79 crore people were screened and 6.4 crore rapid tests were conducted right at people's doorsteps - all free of cost!
  - COVID19 Andhra Pradesh was the fastest state in the country to administer the first dose of vaccine. This was possible only because of the robust and unique Village/Ward Volunteer system created by Jagan Anna government.
- **INFRASTRUCTURE:** Since Independence (roughly 72 years), Andhra Pradesh had only 6 ports, 5 fishing harbours, and 11 medical colleges.

Under Jagan Anna Government, in just 4 years, 4 ports, 10 new fishing harbours, 2 airports, 17 medical colleges and 3 I-T SEZs are nearing completion. And it's not just urban, under CM Jagan, special emphasis was laid on Rural Infrastructure. As many as 10,778 Rythu Bharosa Kendras, 15,004 Sachivalayams, and 10,000 YSR Health Clinics have been established across the State. Going a step forward, the Jagan Anna government has provided 31 lakh house pattas to the poor and another 22 lakh houses are under construction!
